

# Antarctica Revealed by Revealed Travel

The pristine ice wilderness of Antarctica is an unforgettable destination, teeming with an abundance of wildlife and dramatic sights. Antarctica is the coldest, driest and windiest continent on the planet and 98% of it is covered by ice that is at least a mile thick. Follow in the path of the great expeditions from the golden age of polar exploration with modern, spacious and well-designed ships for the journey of a lifetime.

These pages are designed to provide a comprehensive overview to the full range of Antarctic cruises and expeditions. Most itineraries include the Antarctic Peninsula, some include the Falkland Islands, South Georgia and the South Shetland Islands and there are some which travel into the Weddell Sea. Each year just a few itineraries navigate further south from the Antarctic Peninsula to cross into the Antarctic or Polar Circle.

Unquestionably, the longer 18-21 day itineraries which combine the Falklands Islands, South Georgia and Antarctica make for the very best of expeditions for the variety of and abundance of bird and marine life.

Most cruises will start or end in Ushuaia, in southern Argentina, from where it is a day and a half's journey to cross Drake's Passage to reach the Antarctic Peninsula.

If time is short and you don't have particularly good sea-legs, there are some Antarctic Air-Cruises which include flights from Punta Arenas to and from King George Island in the South Shetlands, avoiding crossing Drake's Passage in each direction. The first night is usually in a hotel in Punta Arenas

Itineraries which start or end in Stanley include a flight to/from Chile (either a charter flight from Santiago if joining the RCGS Resolute or a flight from Punta Arenas). Other itineraries which start or end in King George Island include the flight from Punta Arenas across Drake's Passage.

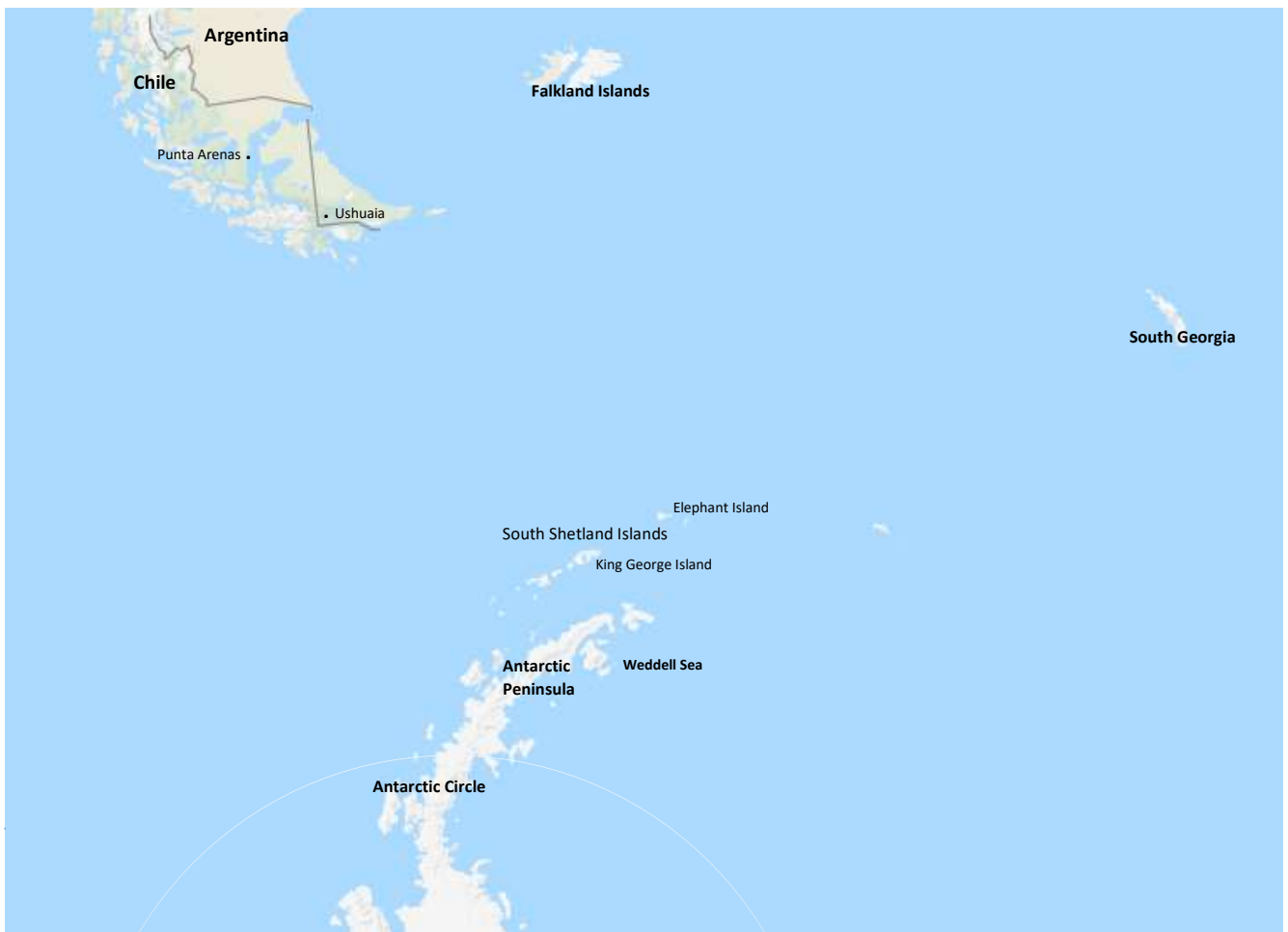
Trips which start in Montevideo (Uruguay), Puerto Madryn or Buenos Aires (Argentina) may include the first night in a hotel but please check details with us. Similarly, itineraries which start in Santiago, Valparaiso or San Antonio (Chile) may include an initial night in a hotel.

The only practical time of the year to go is October to March, avoiding the darkness of the Antarctic winter. Early booking is advisable - usually a year in advance. We will book flights and any land arrangements before/after your expedition cruise.

## Further Information

At the beginning and at the end of the Antarctic season, we have included itineraries which travel down the Pacific coast of South America (e.g. from Lima, Peru) and from or to remote islands such as Easter Island, St Helena and Ascension Island.

We also book tailor-made tours to the Falkland Islands, with flights from RAF Brize Norton or via Chile.

### Antarctic Peninsula

The spectacular Antarctic Peninsula is 600 miles south of Tierra del Fuego across the Drake Passage with impressive peaks such as Mount Owen, Mount Scott and Mount Jackson which are actually a continuation of the Andes. The north-western tip is ice-free for most of the year, making it the most accessible part of Antarctica, attracting vast colonies of penguins and seals and forming the feeding waters for whales. The Gerlache Strait is the centre-piece for most journeys into the western Antarctic Peninsula with stunningly beautiful scenery and an abundant richness of wildlife. Most journeys set out from and return to Ushuaia spending a couple of days crossing the Drake Passage each way. Air-Cruise itineraries fly to the South Shetlands avoiding Drake Passage.

### South Shetland Islands

The South Shetland Islands comprise a collection of 11 major islands including King George Island, Deception Island, Livingston Island and Elephant Island together with a number of minor ones. The South Shetlands are located around 60 miles northwest of the Antarctic Peninsula. Amongst the wildlife, there are colonies of chinstrap penguins, elephant seals breed on the beaches and humpback whales feed in the rich protected waters.

The quickest Antarctic air-cruise itineraries fly from Punta Arenas in Southern Chile to King George Island from where you board your expedition ship to the Antarctic Peninsula. Longer itineraries continue to the Falklands and some also include Elephant Island, which is best known as the place of refuge for Sir Ernest Shackleton's crew after the loss and break-up of the *Endurance* in 1916. Please note that landings on Elephant Island are difficult and not always possible.

### South Georgia

Captain James Cook circumnavigated the island in 1775, made the first landing, claimed it for Great Britain and, for good measure, named it after King George III. South Georgia is 860 miles east-southeast of the Falkland Islands, the greatest breeding and feeding grounds for warm-blooded marine life. The island supports some 5 million fur seals, 100 million sea birds, around half the planet's elephant seals and millions of penguins. The beach at Salisbury Plain alone is the breeding ground for half a million king penguins. Famously, after leaving his men at Elephant Island, Sir Ernest Shackleton reached South Georgia in dramatic journey in an open lifeboat and returned to rescue them. He is buried at Grytviken.





### **Falkland Islands**

Each year a number of expedition cruises include a stop at the Falklands on a journey to South Georgia and/or on to Antarctica. These itineraries usually only stay for a day or two visiting such places as West Point Island, Carcass Island and Stanley. Amongst the birdlife are southern giant petrels, endemic Falkland steamer ducks, kelp and dolphin gulls, black-crowned night herons, red-backed hawks and peregrine falcons. ### **Weddell Sea**

The Weddell Sea, on the eastern side of the Antarctic Peninsula, has a colder climate and more sea ice, making for more difficult navigation and unpredictable landings. But the sight of vast tabular glaciers (perhaps up to a mile in length) coming out of Antarctic Sound is truly breath-taking. Weddell and crab-eater seals, humpback whales, killer and Minke whales and Adelie penguins abound.

### **Polar Circle**

Some of the longer trips to the western Antarctic Peninsula aim to navigate through the spectacularly beautiful narrow passage of Lemaire Channel and push further south to cross the Antarctic Circle. Between October and November the sea ice is too dense so such itineraries usually have to wait until later in the season.

### **Sub-Antarctic Islands (New Zealand)**

There are some magnificent expeditions which travel between Argentina and New Zealand via the Polar Circle and the Ross Sea taking in some of the remote sub-Antarctic islands. There are other trips from New Zealand to Snares Island, Campbell Islands and to Macquarie Island, 1500km south-south-east of Tasmania, which is regarded as the Galapagos of the South. Macquarie Island provides the breeding grounds for an estimated 850,000 Royal Penguins, some 500,000 pairs of Rockhopper Penguins, 100,000 King Penguins and over 5,000 pairs of Gentoo Penguins.

### **Remote Islands/Repositioning**

From Easter Island in the Pacific to St Helena and Tristan da Cunha in the Atlantic or Manaus in the Amazon, there are expedition ships which call in at remote place or travel further afield whilst they are repositioning vessels at the start and end of each season.

Easter Island is over 2,350 miles from the Chilean mainland and more than 2,500 miles from Tahiti. The nearest land is Pitcairn Island, over 1,100 miles away. The island is triangular in shape with an extinct volcano at or near each corner and covers 63 square miles. It is famous for its stone statues which are dotted around the island. A 2017 census recorded the population at 7,750 of whom some 60% are descended from the original Rapa Nui people. There are regular flights between Santiago, Chile and Easter Island and a weekly flight between Tahiti and Easter Island.

St Helena is the island to which Napoleon was exiled after his defeat at the Battle of Waterloo in 1815. It is a tiny speck of land covering just 47 square miles in the South Atlantic Ocean. It is 1200 miles west of Africa and 1800 miles east of Brazil. For hundreds of years it was a stopping point for ships and controlled by the East India Company. There is now a weekly flight between St Helena and Johannesburg, South Africa, which increases to twice a week between December and April.

Tristan da Cunha is the remotest island on the planet. It is the main island in the Tristan da Cunha Archipelago which includes Gough Island and Nightingale Island. Tristan's only settlement, Edinburgh of the Seven Seas, has a population of around 290. Wildlife includes rockhopper penguins, petrels and various species of albatross.

**Recommended Reading:** The Worst Journey in the World by Apsley Cherry-Garrard.

Originally published in 1922, the book has never been out of print. Most recently it has been published by Vintage Classics.

Apsley Cherry-Garrard was a member of the ill-fated Terra Nova Expedition (1910-1913) commanded by Captain Robert Falcon Scott. The title of the book refers to the winter journey he undertook with zoologist Dr Edward "Bill" Wilson and Lieutenant Henry "Birdie" Bowers in July 1911 to Cape Crozier to collect Emperor penguin eggs.

In January 1912, Scott, Wilson, Bowers, Petty Officer Edgar Evans and Captain Lawrence Oates had attempted to reach the South Pole. By mid-April none had returned.

A search party could not set out until after the Antarctic winter. Cherry-Garrard was amongst the group that found the bodies of Scott, Wilson and Bowers on 12 November. Scott's diary revealed that the five had reached the pole on 17 January 1912 but that Norwegian explorer Raoul Amundsen had got there first (5 weeks earlier).

Scott's diary recorded that Evans had collapsed on 16 February and died that night. On 15 March Oates, who was suffering terrible frostbite and did not want to hinder the chances of survival of the others, asked to be left behind. They refused. The following day he left his tent and walked into a raging storm. "He went into the blizzard and we have not seen him since," wrote Scott in his diary entry for 17 March. From the positions of the bodies, they were able to deduce that Scott was the last to die. His last diary entry was on 29 March 1912. It is believed he died shortly afterwards.

Cherry-Garrard was played by Hugh Grant in the seven-part 1985 serial by Central TV, The Last Place on Earth. In the 2007 BBC4 docu-drama, The Worst Journey in the World, Cherry-Garrard was played by Mark Gatiss.
